Pedestrian priorities

Do not overtake vehicles near the pedestrian crossing and adhere to the legal speed limit inside residential neighborhoods and in front of schools.

Always give priority to pedestrians until they complete crossing the road.

Do not overtake vehicles parked to drop off passengers.

□ Taking care of the elderly and people with special needs and give them priority when crossing the road.

Checking vehicles before moving and make sure the surrounding area is free of children or any other obstacles before moving.

Protective driving factors

Application of the measure: taking appropriate steps flexibly and calmly and according to the anticipated dangers to avoid any accident that may occur.
