- _Create websites that broadcast e-messages to combat extremist thought and hate speech.
- _Addressing all inquiries and messages received via the hotline and dealing with important cases promptly.
- _Publishing the Community Peace magazine in both Arabic and English editions.
- _Hosting a flagship radio program titled "Lighthouses" on "Public security directorate FM" radio, shedding light on pertinent societal issues.
